This programme aims to provide participants with the opportunity to develop their understanding of the psychodynamics of work, organisations and the individuals and groups within them. Drawing predominantly on psychoanalytic and systemic concepts, there will be a programme of reading in which participants are invited to review a contemporary paper in the area of consultancy, and/or organisational development and to think about the issues raised in relation to their own area of work.

Time will also be given to discussing work related issues, including aspects of management, organisational development and/or consultancy, as determined by the programme participants.

Applicants are expected to have a minimum of 5 years experience in their respective professions. In addition they will usually be directly involved in the management, training or development of other professional workers or engaged in consultative work for specific organisations. Applicants are expected to have an interest in psychoanalytic ideas and their application to the understanding of organisational dynamics. The programme may be particularly suitable for people who wish to undertake further study in this field
