Clinical Bion: The theoretical and clinical equipment
of the psychoanalyst

Workshop Aims

Following a third successful year of the Donald Meltzer Study Group led by Selina Perocevic and of the public events hosted by NSCAP and the Donald Meltzer Development Fund in 2016 and 2017, we are pleased to host the 3rd Meltzer Study Group morning, which is open to the public and will take place on Saturday 21st July 2018.


This public event will be an opportunity to discuss some of Wilfred Bion's key theoretical and clinical concepts, following a lecture by Dr. Alberto Hahn on the subject of "Clinical Bion" in consideration of his seminal influence on the work of Donald Meltzer. Bion's enlightened and exquisite sensitivity to the working of the unconscious in the clinical situation has left a rich legacy in which he emphasises the importance of the particular state of mind required to sustain an analytic attitude in the analyst and to facilitate the capacity to manage his receptivity to patient's communications.

In order to understand this we are going to examine in some depth the concepts of reverie in analysis, observation, invariant, selected fact, the reversible perspective, negative capability and imaginative conjectures. Some clinical material pertinent to this subject will be presented in the clinical Supervision following the lecture.

The aim in a CPD context is to enhance clinicians sensitivity to the states of mind that underpins their analytic attitude and that of their patients so that they can find their way to a better understanding that adds meaning to their clinical observations. The focus will be on the analyst's state of mind and the management of intimacy in the therapeutic setting. Participants will be encouraged to contribute to the discussion with their own ideas and clinical examples.

Dr. Alberto Hahn MD, is a Fellow of the British Psychoanalytical Society, a lecturer at the Tavistock Clinic in London and at various Institutions abroad where he teaches regularly. He has translated the "Introduction to the work of Bion" by L.Grinberg, and edited "Sincerity : the Collected papers of Donald Meltzer", and with M. Cohen: "Exploring the work of Donald Meltzer: A Festschrift" and "Doing Things Differently. The Continuing Influence of Donald Meltzer in Psychoanalytic Theory and Practice".

He is a Trustee of the Meltzer Development Fund which regularly organises teaching events such as seminars, annual lectures and international conferences in the UK and abroad.



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
