Event outline

Geraldine Shipton, Fellow of the Institute of Psychoanalysis, author of 'Working with Eating Disorders: A Psychoanalytical Approach, Palgrave (2004), will present her paper 'The Diet of Worms: the struggle with internal tyranny in Eating Disorders. This will be followed by live supervision of a case presentation by Martin Gill.

Eating disorders are increasingly prevalent and are part of the wider cultural discourse, they are complex conditions often requiring highly specialised help. Psychoanalytical thinking offers a lens with which these potentially serious and at times fatal conditions can be understood. This morning study event will provide an opportunity to engage in a psychoanalytical conversation on eating disorders.

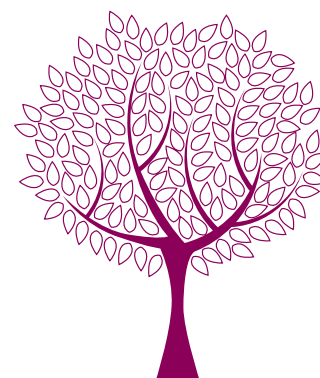
In addition to the clinical presentation in adults, developmental aspects of eating disorders particularly regarding early feeding relationships and adolescence will be considered.

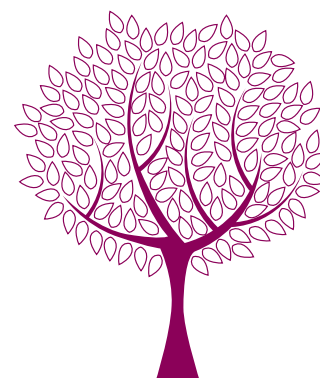

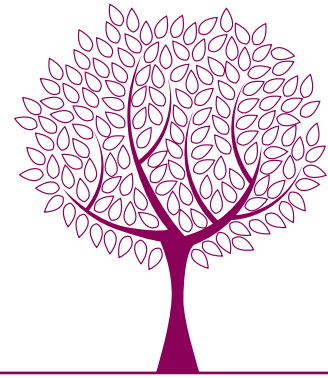

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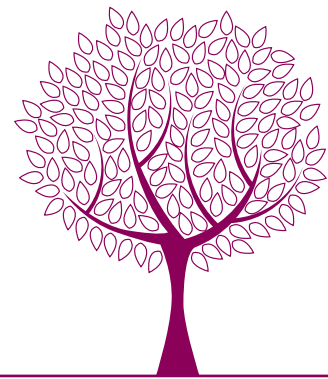
